

NSS activities

2006-2007

- On 29-6-06 fund was collected for Saibaba Deaf & Dumb Association, Sarkhej, Ahmedabad.
- On 20-7-06 Prof. Jaymal Rangia and Prof. Babubhai Patel participated in an Orientation Programme for NSS.
- On 29-6-06 Tree plantation programme was held in the college.
- On 2-8-06 students of the college participated in marathon race organized on the establishment day of Gandhinagar city.
- On 4-8-06 in context with environmental awareness programme a lecture of Prof. Yashvant Pathak was held.
- On 7-8-06 the Thelisemia awareness programme was organized for the student of the college. A lecture was delivered on the subject by Mr. Mukesh Mankad and Mr. Mahesh Trivadi, Secretary of Red Cross Society.
- On 12-8-06 students of the NSS visited Krishna Vrudhashram, Gandhinager and contributed different things of necessity among the aged people staying there.

- A one day seminar on Match Making and Dowry was held on 18th August, 2007 by the Department of Sociology to bring awareness about the evils of dowry.
- NSS orientation programme was held on 26th July, 2007
- On 11th August, 2007, "A Nature Awareness Programme" was held by the unit.
